Richard Steven Lang, AKA Steven (Steve) has been a resident of Wall Township for over 50 years. He graduated from Wall High School and received his Bachelor of Science Degree in Mechanical Engineering Technology for Trenton State College now known as The College of New Jersey. Upon graduating from college, he joined his father in the family auto parts and machine shop business located in Belmar, NJ. During his time in the family business he became an industry recognized expert in automotive machining and as an engine builder.
